### Courses

**RAD 6890. Human Anatomy via Radiology. 3 Credits.**

Conveys the subject of human anatomy. Rather than anatomic dissection, in-vivo anatomy will be presented through medical imaging. Prerequisite: Biology 2000-level equivalent.

**RAD 6990. Special Topics. 1-18 Credits.**

**RAD 6993. Independent Study. 1-18 Credits.**

A course which is tailored to fit the interests of a specific student, which occurs outside the traditional classroom/laboratory setting under the supervision of a faculty member, for which credit is awarded. Offered at department discretion.
