

## EDUCATION (EDSS)

### Courses

**EDSS 6391. Master's Thesis Research. 1-18 Credits.**

Thesis topic must be approved by a faculty committee.

**EDSS 6990. Special Topics. 1-18 Credits.**

See Schedule of Courses for specific titles.

**EDSS 6991. Internship. 1-18 Credits.**

Students will undertake an approved internship in an institution which reflects the particular area of interest and needs of the student.

Prerequisite: Instructor permission.

**EDSS 6993. Independent Study. 1-18 Credits.**

A course which is tailored to fit the interests of a specific student, which occurs outside the traditional classroom/laboratory setting under the supervision of a faculty member, for which credit is awarded. Offered at department discretion.

**EDSS 6994. Teaching Assistantship. 1-3 Credits.**

Student service as a teaching assistant, usually in an introductory level course in the discipline, for which credit is awarded. Offered at department discretion.

**EDSS 6995. Graduate Independent Research. 1-18 Credits.**

Graduate student work on individual or small team research projects under the supervision of a faculty member, for which credit is awarded. Offered at department discretion.
